

# THIS MONTH'S SPEAKER

Taptain Gene Ritter is a commercial diver and president of his company, Research Divers, who holds a 100 ton USCG Master License and has been diving in New York Harbor for over 39 years. Gene is passionate about history as well as diving; he has been featured in prime time newscasts for his underwater discoveries. He has appeared in numerous articles in The New York Times, NY Post, *Daily News*, in trade magazines, also network news such as ABC, NBC, CBS, NY1. He has discovered many historic underwater sites of New York's past, among which are the sunken remnants of Fort Lafayette—a Civil War Fort under the Verrazano Narrows Bridge. Most recently, he located over two thousand anti-aircraft live shells possibly lost by the US Navy in 1954. He found a lost submarine built to explore the ill-fated Andrea Doria; he also discovered the famous Coney Island Dreamland Bell in the waters off Coney Island. On many occasions over the years, Gene has brought hundreds of historic artifacts into schools, community events, and other venues. In 1998, former Brooklyn Borough President Howard Golden awarded Gene his first citation award for Outstanding Contributions to the Preservation of Brooklyn's History.






