



**Aquatic Life Flow Swing Wavemaker** 



Designed to create a dynamic water flow in any aquarium, the Flow Swing Wavemaker

by Macro Aqua, from Aquatic Life, simulates wave movements, connecting to the water return line to spread nutrients to coral and plants throughout the tank while helping to eliminate dead spots in the aquarium. It can oscillate 100 degrees, continuously pushing water through in different directions, creating wave-like currents to spread nutrients and sweep away excess debris and waste products.

The Flow Swing Wavemaker is quiet, maintenance-free and available in three different models to accommodate varying plumbing sizes.

# TIP OF THE MONTH

the winter coming on and heaters back in use, remember to check to see if th e y are working. Replace a n y non-functioning heater with the correct size heater. Allow 10 watts per gallon. Larger aquariums need two heaters to spread heat evenly and quickly throughout the tank. Never test new or old heaters out of water to see if they are working; you will crack the glass and may even receive an electric shock.

To conserve heat in your tank, you can tape insulated sheets of polystyrene to the sides and back of your tank.

You can paint the sheets black or any color you wish.
