NewsDay May 22, 2013 Carp added to pond to devour nuisance plants. Deborah S. Morris.

Heckscher Park pond in Huntington has some new residents - 36 of them to be exact.

Grass carp were introduced into the pond yesterday in an effort to control the growth of hornwort, a thick, underwater sea plant the carp eat. (*Editors Note: Hornwort, Ceratophyllum demersum is a freshwater floating plant; it has no roots, but produces rootlike rhizoids that help it anchor to the substrate.*)

About three years ago, Heckscher Model Yacht Club members, whose boats are hampered by the plant while sailing on the pond, asked the town to consider a natural solution to the problem: stocking the pond with grass carp, a fish with a voracious appetite for hornwort.

After much consideration, the town agreed to the idea last year. "We're happy to move forward on this," Town Supervisor **Frank Petrone** said. "Most of the innovative things that happen in government are a result of a need of an individual or group of people."

The town got permits from the state Department of Environment Conservation to introduce the fish. The DEC required the nonnative fish to be sterile and that a fence be installed so they don't spread to other areas.

As **Ron Lange**, club vice commodore, watched the fish being placed in the pond, he said, "We're hoping that the fish are aggressive enough and can readily clean things up."

He said he and other members would chart the carp's progress each week.

Town officials said state regulations helped determine the amount of fish to be placed. They calculated 10 fish per acre for the 3.6-acre pond.

Babylon officials have said they have successfully used grass carp in their pond at Town Hall and at the town annex in North Babylon since September 2009.


The Brooklyn Aquarium Society Donated Another Aquarium

TIP OF THE MONTH

uring the winter, the heating of your home will evaporate water in your tanks faster then in the summer. Keep an eye on the water level in your tanks; to make sure they're at the proper level. This is particularly important with marine setups. Water evaporates but the salt does not, driving up the salinity of the water.

Freshwater tanks should be kept at a consistent level also, to make sure the filter system works properly and heaters are not exposed to the air. If there is insufficient water level, the filter will stop and possibly break and the heater coil, if exposed, could crack the glass. This could be dangerous to both you and your fish.




