Steinhart Aquarium in California, Laura has seen. many sides of the trade through her work in aquarium retail, wholesale, and


manufacturing. Laura co-created and owned a reef aquarium shop in Bellingham, Washington while earning her B.S. in Marine

## TIP OF THE MONTH

void wide temperature changes when introducing fishes to the tank. Float their transport bags in the aquarium for a few minutes to equalize the water temperature.

(Note: Never float Breather bags in the tank; you could suffocate the fish in the bag since you will be blocking the atmospheric oxygen from entering the bag and carbon dioxide from escaping. Remove fish from these bags and place in a small holding container and float that in the tank.)


