accomplished by one other person in the world, and Kevin is the 1st in the U.S.



transporting livestock home can be a problem. If you know you're going to buy fish or corals, you should have an insulated bag to carry them home. The BAS has developed a great insulated carrying bag for members; with a reflective aluminum foil interior. It has comfortable plastic handles and is constructed with eco-friendly P.E.T (Polyethylene terephthalate). The bag is made from post-consumer water bottles (85% from water bottles,15% from other recycled materials). It's 22"H x 16"W x 11"D. Big enough to carry lots of livestock bags. It also folds up for flat easy

storage. The bag is black with the BAS logo in yellow on one side, and features a unique full Velcro closure to keep your fish and corals safely in and the elements out. Members cost is only \$10. You can purchase one at one of our events

Interested in going to the Peruvian Amazon to collect fish and then bring them back? Copa Airlines has great prices on round trip tickets - LAX to Iquitos for \$700. You will fly from LAX to Panama City, Panama and then a direct flight from PC to Iquitos. I just purchased mine. Will be leaving LAX on Friday, 15 March (take a red eye out of LA and arrive in Iquitos the next day at 2:30 PM) and returning Saturday, 23 March.

The cost break down will look something like this: **Flight** - \$700.00 **Hotel** - \$20 - \$40/day depending on where people stay. The hotel I stay at is \$40 a night, which includes a small kitchenette with fridge and ac, and hot shower. They also have a few of two bedroom places, but am not sure of the cost.

Food - \$15-\$35/day depends on what you like to eat. Grilled chicken and fries around \$7.00


Guide - \$15 / day

MARINE TIP OF THE MONTH

Then feeding marine fish, remember that they will often accept aquatic live foods that are used to feed freshwater fish, but keep in mind that these live foods may not live as long in sea water. Livebearer fry may survive longer than other freshwater fry.

Also, remember that many marine fish need to have green matter in their diets. Others may be herbivorous and will only eat green matter. So keep a bright light on your tank to help encourage lush growths of algae for these fish to feed on.

Keep an eye on the fish when you feed them and remove any uneaten food; otherwise, it will begin to pollute the water. Never overfeed. Fish are not like people; they do not have to eat three times a day.

For freshwater fish, the same holds true. Do not feed them more than they can consume in 5 to 15 minutes. Smaller feeding at regular intervals throughout the day is better than one big feeding.

If you have nocturnal feeders, Loaches, etc., feed them at night when the lights are out with sinking food pellets so that they get to feed without competition from the day feeders.






