

Animals are the stars at Brooklyn Zoo and Aquarium

The pets here get air time.

And we don't mean they go for strolls in the park.

The animals at The Brooklyn Zoo and Aquarium pet store have had more than 15 minutes of fame. Accompanied by the shop's employees, they have made guest appearances on television programs such as MTV's "Real World," Maury Povich's talk show, and some of the alligators even attended the premiere of the movie, "Crocodile Hunter."

"We have more live animals than any of the large pet stores, by far, and at 4,500 square feet, we are the only pet superstore in Brooklyn that's independently owned and operated," said Peter Eppolito, the shop's owner.

No wonder Hollywood called upon them to set up the 100-gallon tank for "Real World." The tank was a mesmerizing exhibit, built into a wall, that allowed the aquarium to be viewed from both sides, says Eppolito. Aquarium maintenance and set-up is one of the shop's specialties.

"We have custom-built aquariums for restaurants and for people's homes," says Eppolito. The Brooklyn Zoo and Aquarium is family-owned and operated, so it was Eppolito's sister, Debra, who got to appear on the Maury Povich show, to talk about pet phobias. Eppolito had the honor of appearing on Bloomberg Television, in a segment that had a tarantula making stock picks.

"I took two tarantulas on the train, in case there was a problem with one," he says. For the show, paperwork was placed on the floor, and a tarantula was released. "Whatever stocks it walked on, were the stocks it picked."

Did it make any money?

"I never followed the stocks to see how they turned



out," Eppolito says. He was just happy that the tarantula's television debut was a successful one.

When the movie "Crocodile Hunter" came to the Sheepshead Bay Movie Theater, Eppolito was asked to set up a display of baby alligators for photo-taking.

"People were allowed to touch them, and have their pictures taken," he says.

Eppolito grew up in Old Mill Basin, and as a kid, was surrounded by lots of animals, especially reptiles. Some things never change.

There are three family members working with him at the shop, which has been in business for 23 years.

"We're the same reliable staff, and have developed a trust with all our customers," he says. "We've always provided attentive customer service, pet expertise and competitive prices, above and beyond what the big chain stores can provide. Animals are our passion, and that's what keeps our customers loyal after all these years."

TIP OF THE MONTH

eep in mind that you must keep a constant check on the water conditions in your marine aquarium. Marie fish are less tolerant of changing conditions than freshwater fish. Also remember the number of marine fish you can keep is much smaller than the number of tropical freshwater fish species that you can keep in a similar size tank.
