


Joe Graffagnino, President



ou should always think safety when dealing with water and electricity Air and water filter pumps should be situated above the water level, but we all know that most of the time this is not practical since they are offen placed under the aquarium. If this is the case you

should alway create an antisiphon loop in your air-line and your electric power cord this loop in the line will prevent water from accidentally leaking from the filter or air pump and stop it from coming in contact with your electric outlet.


