TP OF THE MONTH

Spring is one of the best times to check your local fish store to see what fish are coming in. As the weather gets better, shipments of fish arrive in better condition. Check out society auctions. Local breeders bring fish bred over the winter to these events. Homebred fish are usually healthier than farm-raised fish that have been stressed out by a long trip in a styro from Florida and Far East farms.

This is also a good time for mail ordering fish eggs. Killifish and rainbow fish eggs travel well and have a much better chance of arriving in good condition.




