



Post your question as a normal online post in the Q & A section. Anyone may post an answer and get 1 point. The answer is posted as a reply. The question remains open for a week. The author of the best answer gets an additional 3 points. If the question is not answered or is incorrect by the end of that week, the experts on our Board of Directors will choose or provide a best answer. The first round of Q & A begins at our October event and runs until December 31, 2014. The persons with the most points for answers and for questions will each win \$20 in BA\$ Bucks, or a free 1 year (individual) BAS membership or a one year subscription to an aquatic magazine. 



quatic plants do more than just look pretty in your aquarium. Floating aquatic plants, (such as Java moss, *Vesicularia dubyana*; Milfoil, *Myriophyllum aquaticum*; Willow moss, *Fontinalis antipyretica*; Cabomba, *Cabomba caroliniana*, and Hornwort, *Ceratophyllum demersum*) are easily propagated, given enough light, and are excellent in the breeding tank, offering shelter to stressed fish, sites to lay eggs and places for fry to hide and find microscopic foods. Plants also offer herbivorous fishes something to nibble on. They are natural biological filters as well.

If you want to cut down on algae blooms, stock your aquarium with lots of plants, both rooted and floating. Floating plants do an excellent job of robbing algae of nutrients and light.

Plants also give your aquarium a natural look and they make the fish feel at ease.






