

THIS MONTH'S SPEAKER

Richard Pierce has been keeping fish for as long as he can remember. His interest in all things aquatic led to degrees in Marine Biology and Biological Oceanography. He has worked in 2 retail aquarium stores and in two public aquaria.

He currently maintains approximately 1200-gallons in 120 aquaria in his fish room. Since his

largest aquarium is 65-gallons, most of his fish are small. Although he keeps and enjoys all kinds of fish, killifish, wild-type livebearers and characins are of particular interest right now.

In addition to fish keeping, Richard enjoys photography, especially photographing fish and macro photography. He has won awards in both the American Killifish Association and NEC photo contests, and now chairs the annual NEC photo contest. He has spoken at many aquarium societies throughout the country and enjoys meeting other aquarists and visiting their fish rooms.

Richard has been an active member of the Tropical Fish Society of Rhode Island since 2003 and is currently Breeder's Award Program Chair. He is also active in the American Killifish Association, and served as its Chairman from 2013 - 2015. He is Vice-President of the Northeast Council of Aquarium Societies and chairs their Breeders Participation Program. Finally, he is the President of the Southern New England Killifish Association (SNEKA).

TIP OF THE MONTH

ood is a favorite decoration for aquariums. Make sure that any wood used is long dead and should be boiled and sealed before being placed in your aquarium. The best place to get safe wood that has been correctly processed is your local aquarium store. Some of the wood branches may be attached to a slate plate to keep it from floating.

Plants like Java fern like to grow on driftwood. You can easily attach the plant with clear fishing line. After a while, the Java fern will attach its roots to the wood and the fishing line can be removed.

PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES FOR GROUP INTERACTIONS:



- Thank you for helping us foster a warm and fruitful environment for you and all the members.








