



THIS MONTHS SPEAKER

ur speaker for this month, **Rit Forcier**, has kept tropical fish since age 10. Rit has been a member of the former Aqua Land Aquatic Society, Bristol, CT, since 1982 and became its President in 1986. He was Past President of the Exotic Fish Society of Hartford, 1985. The two clubs merged in 2009 and formed the Greater Hartford AS.

He is co-founder and first Chairman of the Northeast Livebearer Association, and currently its Treasurer and Membership Chair, as well as a member of the American Livebearers Association for over 15 years. Rit was elected to the ALA Board of Directors in September of 2002, a position he still holds. He became Vice Chairman in April of 2003 and elected Chairman of the Board of Directors in Oct. 2003 and reelected four times. He was honored by Aqualand in December of 1999 with an honorary lifetime membership for his "sincere dedication and generous support."

In addition, he is an honorary lifetime member of the Pioneer Valley Aquarium Society (MA), 2006 Recipient of the Betty Mueller Award from the Northeast Council of Aquarium Societies for his contributions to the hobby. His articles have been published in many hobby magazines, including TFH. He maintains 45 tanks, some of which do not contain livebearers. He has been an auctioneer for many clubs, including ALAS, PVAS, Nassau (LI) and NEC.

His livebearers have won Best of Show at Aqualand in 1996, and third place in the Wm. T. Innes competition of the Northeast Council in March of 2010, among other honors. He earned the Breeder designation of the Northeast Council in 1990, and Master Breeder in 1999. He holds Senior Breeder status in the ALA.

In real life, Rit is a computer consultant. He travels half the year teaching programmers to write programs.

Rit is a fun guy and a great speaker and very knowledgeable about fishkeeping, so if you want to learn about goodeids and livebearers, this is a not to be missed event.
