





# NAPIECE OF THE RAIN FOREST

# The Foundation is currently supporting two causes:

- 1) Rain Forest Preservation. We're helping purchase rain forest to set aside from deforestation and agricultural use. The Foundation is supporting an established NGO that has forest preserves and the opportunity to add to those reserves. The target now is the purchase of two tracts; one 30 acres for \$2,400 and the other 50 acres for \$3,500.
- 2) Supporting research aimed at higher survival of wild caught tropical fish through the identification and treatment of fish diseases, improved holding and shipping methods, all in an effort to increase the survival rate of wild caught fish that are shipped to hobbyists.

# TIP OF THE MONTH

Then feeding your reef invertebrates, always switch off your power filter for a short time. This will prevent the foods made of liquidizing usual aquarium food from being extracted by the filtration system before your corals get a chance to ingest them. Also remove any uneaten foods when the fish lose interest in it. This holds true for both fresh and marine fish aquariums. You should in both cases feed only a little at a time if you can, and at regular intervals.

# JOE GRAFFAGNINO'S NEW ADVENTURE FANTASY Ma Li & Mary



The brave men who entered that blazing inferno walked into a deathtrap – unknown internal fans spread the fire. Water outlets, both inside and outside the building were bone dry.


