# TIP OF THE MONTH

When setting up a new tank, always plan in advance and make sure you have everything you need close at hand.

If you're planning to decorate the tank, it's a good idea to draw a plan of where you intend to place the rocks, drift wood and plants. Generally, keep the taller and bunch plants towards the back and the low growing plants towards the front. If you have schooling fish, make sure you leave an open space for them to swim in and enough hiding places for shyer fish.

Čareful planning always pays off in setting up a new aquarium.

# JOE GRAFFAGNINO'S NEW BOOK ~ THE FIX IS IN ~

The fire that consumed the Deutsche Bank building was one of the worst fires in New York City's history. The 9/11 damaged building at 130 Liberty Street, near the apex of the World Trade Center, quickly became outof-control and escalated into a seven alarm inferno that killed two firefighters, and injured 105. One of the firefighters



The brave men who entered that blazing inferno walked into a deathtrap – unknown internal fans spread the fire. Water outlets, both inside and outside the building were bone dry.

After eight years of relentless research in pursuit of the truth – interviewing firefighters on the scene, government officials, observers, whistleblowers and eyewitnesses -

Graffagnino uncovered the disturbing truth about a calculated conspiracy that
