## In Memoriam: Dr. Herbert R. Axelrod (1927 - 2017)

**Dr. Herbert Axelrod** has died at the age of 89. Ichthyologist, author, explorer, entrepreneur, philanthropist and publisher with a controversial history, who once dominated and then receded from the hobby.

The author and publisher Dr. Herbert Richard Axelrod passed away at his Swiss home on May 15, 2017, with tentative reports trickling out over the subsequent days — articles from online Violin publications followed word-of-mouth announcements between friends of those close to him. In most camps, the news has been greeted with sadness, while some of those with whom he collided throughout his life have been less morose: in death, as in life, Axelrod is divisive.

# OWN A PIECE OF THE RAIN FOREST


# The Foundation is currently supporting two causes:

The target now is the purchase of two tracts; one 30 acres for \$2,400 and the other 50 acres for \$3,500.
- **2)** Supporting research aimed at higher survival of wild caught tropical fish through the identification and treatment of fish diseases, improved holding and shipping methods, all in an effort to increase the survival rate of wild caught fish that are shipped to hobbyists.

# TIP OF THE MONTH

t is important that you keep an eye on the water conditions in your marine tank. A constant check is important since marine fish are much less tolerant of changing water conditions than their freshwater counterparts.

Maintain the pH value of the water in the aquarium in the range of 7.9 to 8.3. A falling pH value means that the water is losing its ability to remain in a stable condition, when this happens do a water change.






# JOE GRAFFAGNINO'S NEW BOOK ~ THE FIX IS IN ~

he fire that consumed the Deutsche Bank building was one of the worst fires in New York City's history. The 9/11 damaged building at 130 Liberty Street, near the apex of the World Trade Center, quickly became out-of-control and escalated into a seven alarm inferno that killed two firefighters, and injured 105. One of the firefighters

killed was author Graffagnino's son.

Graffagnino refused to believe what decision makers told the public – that the fire was an accident.



The brave men who entered that blazing inferno walked into a deathtrap – unknown internal fans spread the fire. Water outlets, both inside and outside the building were bone dry.


After eight years of relentless research in pursuit of the truth – interviewing firefighters on the scene, government officials, observers, whistle-blowers and eyewitnesses – Graffagnino uncovered the disturbing truth about a calculated conspiracy that

involved governmental agencies, corporate leaders and organized crime figures.






